NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and the SLSC PHRF rules.

All yachts will be required to display an approved bow number on the Port and Starboard side of the bow. The bow number material will be available at registration time.

2. ADVERTISING

This will be a category C event.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The 2008 END-OF-SUMMER-HUMMER is an open event for keelboats.

Eligible boats may enter by emailing the online registration form to [Al Fisher](#). The attached waiver signed by the crew and the required fees must be submitted by September 12, 2200 Hrs to the Sylvan Lake Sailing Club Hummer registration desk.

All boats registered prior to September 6 will be eligible for a draw for a prize at the Howl. The value of the prize will depend on the generosity of our sponsors, but could be well in excess of \$50.00!

The entry fee is \$100.

4. CLASSIFICATION

The ISAF Sailor Classification Code will apply.

5. SCHEDULE

Early registration deadline	September 6

Warning Signal for first race of the day	Saturday September 13	10:00
Warning Signal for first race of the day	Sunday September 14	09:00

The last race on Sunday, September 14 will not start later than 15:00 hours.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available upon completion of registration at the Sylvan Lake Sailing Club.

7. VENUE

The 2008 END-OF-SUMMER-HUMMER will be held September 13-14, 2008 at Sylvan Lake, Alberta.

8. THE COURSES

The courses for divisions I and II will be of the Windward/Leeward type with a downwind finish. Division III competitors will sail a triangle course with a downwind finish.

9. SCORING

Seven races are scheduled of which one race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

(a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from five to seven races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10. HANDICAPPING

The corrected time will be calculated using PHRF Time-On-Time handicapping formula. The conversion formula to Time-on-Time ratings is $700/(550+PHRF)$.

11. DIVISIONS

There will be three divisions:

- Division I - PHRF Class Boats - 189 & less
- Division II - PHRF Class Boats - 190 & greater
- Division III - PHRF Class Boats - Recreation

The results of Division II & I count towards the 2008 Quantum Alberta Grand Prix Racing Series.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Keel boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

14. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In participating in the event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organizing authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show,
